## APPEAL

Appeals of Land Use Decisions are allowed within fourteen days from the date the Final Decision is mailed.

**Talk to a City Planner**: If you are interested in appealing a Final Decision, you may wish to discuss your concerns with one of the City Planners. A preliminary conference may assist you in understanding the procedures and timelines for the Appeal. Remember to have standing for an appeal, it must be submitted in a timely manner.

**Submit your Application**: A completed, written application on forms provided by the Planning Division and application fee is required. The appeal application must include a written description of the specific items on which the appeal is based. Please cite the specific errors or issues upon which the appeal is based, including an explanation of why the decision is not consistent with the Yakima Urban Area Comprehensive Plan, Yakima Urban Area Zoning Ordinance, or other provision of law or policy.

**The Review Process**: After ensuring a complete application has been submitted, the Planning Division will set the time and place for the hearing of the appeal. The Hearing Examiner shall preside over hearings of appeals.

**Public Notice**: At least 10 days prior to the date of the hearing, the official whose decision is being appealed, the appellant, and other parties of record will be notified of the date and time of the public hearing.

**Appeal Decision Issued**: Following the public meeting or public hearing a Final Decision regarding the appeal will be issued in writing. If you attend the public meeting or hearing and sign-in, you will be sent a copy of the decision regarding the appeal.
