

RECYCLING REMINDERS

What to include in your curbside recycling cart

plastic containers

PREPARATION: empty · quick rinse · no lids

recycle plastics by shape ignore numbers

plastic bottles, milk jugs, plastic tubs, plastic jars, buckets

paper and cardboard

PREPARATION: clean · dry · quick rinse for milk and juice cartons

milk and juice cartons, paper or frozen food boxes, cardboard, paper bags, newspaper, phone books, mail, magazines, mixed paper and catalogs

aluminum and tin cans

PREPARATION: empty · quick rinse · no loose lids · do not crush

aluminum cans, metal cans

NO GLASS
NO PLASTIC BAGS OR WRAP
NO DANGEROUS MATERIALS

GARBAGE COLLECTION IS EVERY TUES.



YARD WASTE SERVICE REMINDERS:

Yard Waste will be collected on Fridays, Every Other Week, (EOW) during the Pilot Program.



Please place grass clippings, leaves and small branches in your green yard waste cart. Small branches should be cut into 3ft lengths or less and not exceed 3 inches in diameter. All yard waste must fit inside the cart with lids closed.

UNACCEPTABLE ITEMS

- GARBAGE
- FOOD SCRAPS
- ASHES
- BUILDING MATERIAL, ROCKS
- PLASTIC BAGS
- ANIMAL WASTE
- SOD, DIRT
- TREE TRUNKS OR LARGE BRANCHES

NOTE: Our trucks can pick up yard waste carts weighing up to 150 pounds. Carts filled to capacity with some materials can exceed the weight limit and will not be emptied.

Holiday Schedule: There will be no refuse service on July 4th. Please have carts out on Saturday July 5th for collection.
