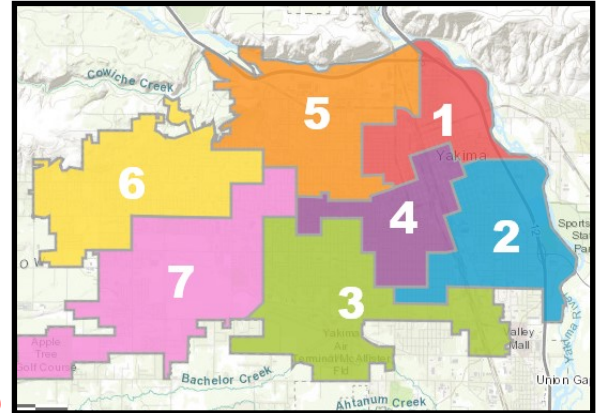

WHAT IS GOING ON: To help keep our community clean and green the City of Yakima is sponsoring a one day FREE COMMUNITY CLEAN UP Saturday April 21st from 8:00 AM to 1:00 PM. Staffed dumpsters will be available at the Public Works Parking lot for your use. Take this opportunity to clean up items that may be stacking up in your yard making your community unsightly and unsafe. This year the clean up is available to the residents in District 5: Lincoln to River Rd; N 16th to N 34th Ave.



PLEASE FOLLOW THESE INSTRUCTIONS

ACCEPTABLE MATERIALS

- Household garbage—**MUST** be bagged or boxed
- Tires—Passenger and small trucks only. Rims ok. **NO MORE THAN 4 TIRES PER HOUSEHOLD.**
- Yard waste - clippings and trimmings only. No sod or stumps. Bundle brush and branches; cut into 4' lengths
- Electronics and slightly used household items will be accepted.
- Metals—washers, dryers, stoves, hot water tanks. Must be kept separate for recycling

PLEASE FOLLOW THESE INSTRUCTIONS

WASTE NOT ACCEPTED

- No Commercial Waste
- No Construction and Demolition Debris
- No concrete
- Household Hazardous Waste **will not be** accepted at this event. **The Terrace Hts. Landfill will accept HHW Free of Charge.**
- **LOADS LARGER THAN ONE PICK UP BED WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.**
