Complete Streets for Yakima!

Complete Streets are designed and operated to enable safe access for all users, including pedestrians, bicyclists, motorists, and transit riders of all ages and abilities, and the movement of freight.



Benefits of Complete Streets

- **Health:** provide the ability to walk or bike safely and comfortably
- **Economy:** attract businesses and shoppers, and encourage revitalization
- **Accessibility:** allow access to services for those who do not drive, such as children, elderly, and low-income residents
- **Environment:** reduce air pollution and provide an attractive and pleasing setting
- **Social:** reduce crime by increasing “eyes on the street” and encouraging social interaction




What You Can Do
